Contraband Policy

Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s),

Listed below is the updated contraband policy for Keone'ula Elementary School. Please contact the school office at 307-2100 if you have any questions or concerns.

The following items are prohibited at Keone'ula Elementary School:

- Plastic/wooden toy swords, knives and/or guns are prohibited
- Toys and cards of any type, including footballs, basketballs, soccer balls, playing cards, Pokemon cards, **fidget spinners**, etc...
- Other items not allowed in school, including but not limited to skateboards, rip sticks, scooters, rollerblades/skates, heeies, etc...
- Electronic devices (e.g. cell phones, games, toys, etc.)

Should students bring a contraband item to school: first offense, the student may pick up the confiscated item at the end of the day. If item(s) are confiscated again, the office will hold the item and a parent/guardian will be required to pick up the item from the office. If item(s) are confiscated again, the office will hold the item till the end of the school year; parents will NOT be asked to come pick up the item.

This policy is in place to insure all students will be able to learn in a safe environment. As a parent/guardian, you play a critical role in the academic and social success of your child(ren).

Exceptions to this list will be made for medical reasons when a note from a licensed physician is presented to the school.
